Since the outbreak of the COVID-19 virus pandemic, Goodwill Industries of Central Alabama (GICA) has been continually evaluating ways to provide service to the community and conduct our normal operations. As we learned more about the virus' effects, we were able to focus on creating safe programs and workplaces for our employees and clients. In an effort to blunt the spread of the virus, masks and sanitizers were made readily available in our workplaces and stores. We also strongly encouraged all employees to receive the COVID vaccine.

While we continued to manage our COVID recovery, we were able to maintain our employment services for people with disabilities. Tom “Red” Perry was in a car accident in 2001. He suffered a spinal cord injury that left him paralyzed from the waist down. When Red first had the accident he felt depressed and overwhelmed. He worked hard to overcome those feelings and instead have a positive, upbeat attitude on life. Red has been working for Goodwill a little over two years. He works at the Eastern Boulevard retail store. The state has provided Red with an electric wheelchair to use while he is working at the store. The chair allows him to take on larger tasks at work. He enjoys greeting donors, collecting donations and helping his team members.
